Grand Power Receives Approval to Establish Branch Office in Guangzhou, PRC

Calgary, Alberta and Hong Kong - Grand Power Logistics Group Inc. ("Grand Power") is pleased to announce that Grand Power Express Forwarders Co. Ltd. of Shanghai ("GP Shanghai"), one of the Grand Power Logistics Group of Companies, has received approval from the Bureau of Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation of Guangzhou Municipality to open a Branch Office in Guangzhou, in The People's Republic of China ("PRC").

Guangzhou is the capital city and economic centre of the Province of Guangdong on the Pearl River Delta, one of the most prolific industrial regions in the world and a modern logistics hub for air, sea, road, and rail transportation.

The Guangzhou Port is one of the 10 largest seaports in the world and the new Baiyun International Airport is one of the largest and most modern international airports in China. In a recent public statement, the Guangzhou Municipality indicated that "Industry insiders project that more than 30 percent of China's imported and exported cargo will transit through Guangzhou, opening up excellent prospects for the city's airport logistics industry."

Ricky Chiu, President and CEO of Grand Power Logistics Group said "Our presence in Guangzhou is another significant regional development for the Grand Power Group of Companies and consistent with our business strategy of expanding into the key logistics hubs in China. There is tremendous demand for logistics services in this region which is why we planned to be there. Now that approval has been obtained to open its Branch Office, GP Shanghai can now proceed to complete the remaining licensing and registration process to begin operations, expected in the near future."

Mr. Chiu adds, "We will now be able to work directly with customers in Guangzhou rather than deal through other licensed agents, further increasing our market share, revenue and margins. We will continue with this effective strategy of expanding our market share in China by opening Branch Offices in other centres to meet the increasing demand for logistics services in the region."

Through its Branch Office in Guangzhou, GP Shanghai will be able to directly offer its customers access to the air freight and other value-added logistics services that the Company provides through its established network of airline partners and other key relationships in the region.

GPW commenced business in Hong Kong in March 2002 primarily as an airfreight forwarding service, but also provides sea freight services, customs brokerage, logistics, warehousing and distribution, as well as other value added services for clients. The Grand Power Group is uniquely positioned in Asia, with its headquarters in Hong Kong and subsidiaries or supporting offices in Macau, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Taipei and Bangkok.
