AND OPENS NEW HONG KONG HEADQUARTERS**

("Grand Power", TSX Venture - "GPW") is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Nelson Wong as Managing Director of Grand Power Express International Limited (GP Express) and Mr. Winton Chan as General Manager, Operations. The Company also announces the relocation of its operations to its new headquarters in Hong Kong.

Mr. Wong, Managing Director, has over 20 years of extensive management and operations experience in both aviation and logistics sectors in Hong Kong and Southern China, two of the key regions that GP Express will continue to aggressively develop. His experience includes corporate leadership in all logistics sectors in which GP Express will be developing a stronger presence.
